

Carolina Park Pool Rules



- The pool is for the exclusive use of Carolina Park Residents only. No more than 3 Guests are allowed per home at any one time.
- The pool is open from 7 am – 8 pm 7 days per week for all family members. From Memorial Day until Labor Day, the pool is open from 6:30 am – 8:30 pm.
- Any person not bathroom independent, regardless of age, is required to wear a swim diaper.
- The pool attendant, when present, will blow a whistle to announce a 10 minute safety break at the end of each hour. Children under the age of 15 are required to exit the pool during this time.
- Pool parties are not permitted.
- Swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Glass is not allowed in the pool area. Please be aware that if glass is found, the pool may need to be drained causing prolonged pool closure and extra expense that can be charged to the person bringing and/or breaking glass in the area.
- Alcohol is not allowed in the pool area. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs should not use the pool.
- Carolina Park is a smoke free facility. Smoking is not permitted in the pool, playground, or any other common areas.
- Audio devices may only be used with headphones.
- Pets are not allowed at the pool.
- Boisterous, rough play, offensive activity, and/or offensive language is not permitted.
- Swimmers must wear appropriate swim attire.
- Skateboards, scooters, and bicycles are not allowed inside the pool gate.
- Large floats, rafts, or any other large floatation device that may pose a hazard to swimmers are not allowed in the pool.
- Diving is not allowed.
- Solo swimming is not allowed.
- Persons with diarrheal illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
- **ANYONE** violating the rules will be asked to leave and their pool access denied.

If you have lost your pool key fob, please contact management and a new one will be issued. There is a \$25 charge for each new key.

The pool is a valuable asset to the HOA. In the interest of maintaining this asset, please be sure that the rules are followed. For additional rules, please see the posted POOL RULES sign. Each pool user is responsible for their own clean up.
