

Carolina Park Pool Rules



- The pool is for the use of Carolina Park Residents and their accompanied guests. Up to 3 guests per household are permitted.
- The pool is open from 7 am – 8 pm 7 days per week for all family members. From Memorial Day until Labor Day, the pool is open from 6:30 am – 8:30 pm.
- Swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Carolina Park is a smoke free facility. Smoking is not permitted in the pool, playground, or any other common areas.
- Alcohol is not allowed in the pool area. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs should not use the pool.
- Glass is not allowed in the pool area. Please be aware that if broken glass is found, the pool may need to be drained causing prolonged pool closure and extra expenses that can be charged to the person bringing and/or breaking glass in the area.
- Business activities such as swim lessons are prohibited. Owners can bring a swim instructor into the pool with them as an accompanied guest during non-peak hours. The instructor should leave with the same owner, teach in a quiet, non-disruptive manner, and all pool rules must be followed (ex- exiting the pool during the 10-minute safety break).
- Any person not bathroom independent, regardless of age, is required to wear a swim diaper.
- The pool attendant, when present, will blow a whistle to announce a 10 minute safety break at the end of each hour. Lap swimming ONLY is permitted during this time.
- Pool parties are not permitted.
- Audio devices may only be used with headphones.
- Pets are not allowed at the pool.
- Boisterous, rough play, offensive activity, and/or offensive language is not permitted. Skateboards, scooters, and bicycles are not allowed inside the pool gate.
- Large floats, rafts, surfboards or any other large flotation devices that may pose a hazard to swimmers are not allowed in the pool. If more than one child can fit on a float, this is considered too large.
- Diving is not allowed. Solo swimming is not allowed.
- **ANYONE** violating the rules will be asked to leave and their pool access denied.

If you have lost your pool key fob, please contact management at (843)971-1210 or hoa@carolinapark.com and a new one will be issued. There is a \$25 charge for each new key.

The pool is a valuable asset to the HOA. In the interest of maintaining this asset, please be sure that the rules are followed. For additional rules, please see the posted POOL RULES sign. Each pool user is responsible for their own clean up.
